

## STANDARDS OF CONDUCT FOR NATIONAL GUARD TECHNICIANS

Each technician has a positive duty to acquaint themselves with each statute that relates to their ethical and other conduct as a technician in the National Guard and as an employee of the Federal Government. The standards of conduct specified for technicians I/A/W FM Chapter 735 are as follows:

- a. Activities related to private interest.
- b. Membership in nongovernment organizations.
- c. Solicitation of contributions.
- d. Use OF Government facilities, property of services.
- e. Outside employment.
- f. Additional compensation.
- g. Gambling.
- h. Indebtedness.
- i. General conduct.
- j. Acceptance of gifts, entertainment, or favors,
- k. Misuse of information.
- l. Engagement in riots or civil disorders.
- m. Dealing with military of civilian personnel.
- n. Bribery and graft.

Each technician is required to sign this statement that he/she understands the Standards of Conduct as outlined in FPM Chapter 735.
