AREA OF CONSIDERATION: Open to Army National Guard service members in the West Virginia Army National Guard or service members of other States eligible to transfer to the West Virginia Army National Guard. **THIS POSITION IS BASED ON THE AVAILABILITY OF RESOURCES**	
DUTIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO: Prepare for and conduct Mass Casualty Decontamination Course (MCDC) as a Decontamination Subject Matter Expert (SME) for the CERFP (CBRNE Enhanced Response Force Package). SME will work with 17 CERFP Teams and 10 HRF Teams (CBRNE TF Element only) throughout the United States. Primary area of focus- SME will instruct Mass Human Decontamination Course, which focuses on the three-lane concept for set up that include, Ambulatory, Non Ambulatory, and Technical DECON while also explaining the importance of establishing the liquid and vapor control lines prior to set up of all three lanes. The DECON SME is responsible for ensuring DECON personnel are performing all task IOW The MCDC POI using the T&EO and all applicable FMs and references. SME will also provide Mobile Training and evaluation on a rotational basis with other OC/T instructors ensuring the MCDC stays informed of current best practices in use by the 27 Decontamination teams. SME will provide instruction on monitoring equipment including but not limited to Military issued equipment and civilian issued detection and monitoring equipment for both Radiation threats and Chemical hazards. SME supports ADVON /Main Body DECON teams by providing guidance and training in selecting a suitable site layout for not only the decontamination line, but the entire main body when they occupy the site. Included in this task is providing guidance and training to the maintenance section IOT find a suitable place for their equipment, as well as a liquid waste point based on event factors including wind direction, slope, and likely path of waste run off. ADDITIONAL DUTIES INCLUDE: Support the CERFP Operations, Training, and Logistics sections, remaining current on all annual training requirements and NCOES Schools.
